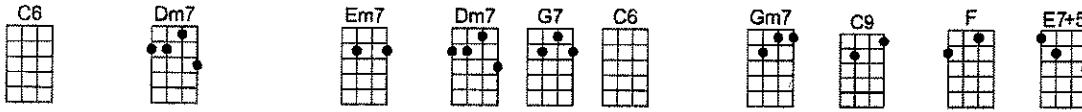

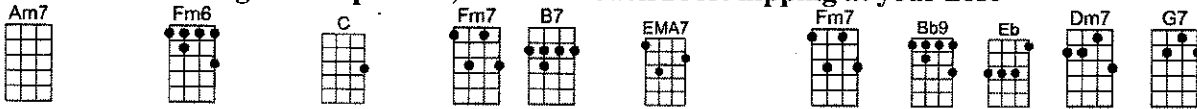

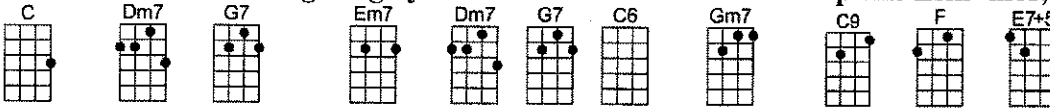

Jack Frost nipping at your nose



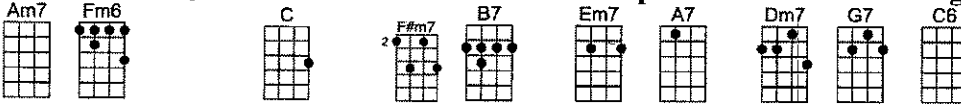
